Inspiration:

“Iris” the name is derived from the word “iridescence” which means a lustrous rainbow like play of color caused by differential refraction of light waves (as from an oil slick, soap bubble, or fish scales) that tends to change as the angle of view changes.

The idea was to design a corner table which appears solid but gradually changes colours with a change in the viewing angle.

Since life is ever changing and nothing is permanent, there is an utmost need to view it from different angles and accept the reality.

The base of the table has an organic shape in a pearlescent finish. Pearlescence is a related effect where some or all of the reflected light is white, where iridescent effects produce only other colours. The term pearlescent is used to describe certain paint finishes, usually in the automotive industry, which actually produce iridescent effects.

The solid base holds the glass which is fragile and crackled giving it a character but it still mirrors the shape of the base.
